Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

Aug 15, 2014

What a month and ½ we have had. I guess I should start off where I left you last prayer letter. Went to Singapore and had all my heart checks done within 36 hours of arrival. The virus had done absolutely no damage to my heart. In fact the cardiologist was surprised at how healthy my heart is for my age. I thank you for your prayers. We changed our flights to come back early but still had 5 days on our hands. Sunday we went to Maranatha Baptist church and met Pastor Jesse and many wonderful folks there. They checked us out of our hotel and we stayed with Bro Dan and Sis Sue and family for 3 great days of fellowship. I was encouraged and from the feedback we helped them also. That Weds there were almost 18 people from the church seeing Gwendy and I off from the airport.

We also were able to witness to many people at the hospital, on the trains, and walking around. Remember in prayer: Farasi-16 year old Muslim girl, Jungan, older Hindu woman, Edward, Agnostic Taiwanese Semi-Conductor engineer and others, from Malaysia, China, Switzerland, and other places. Some who had never heard about Jesus Christ dying for their sins. Pray for Maranatha Baptist Church also as they are definitely in the fight.

We arrived back on a Thursday and went back to Pangia on Fri. then Sat went to market and had some good witnessing and Sunday preached in Pangia (first preaching in 7 weeks due to being sick). Well Sunday night came down with chills. Temp next few days went up to 104.2 several times. It was regular so we headed to Hagen Weds. to get Dylan Parfit who had come to help with printing. Thursday went to Kudjip, and they didn't know what was going on. They did give me 2 I.V. bags and sent me on. Next 48 hours I got about 30 minutes of sleep. Chad ended up taking Dylan back to Pangia and Gwendy, Wesley and I stayed in Hagen. Sat. morning Gwendy said, "You need to go look in the mirror", well would you believe it, I had the measles. (Dylan came down with it 10 days later). It has been tough but God has been good and I have learned a lot. Two weeks and 16lbs lighter. Amen.

So finally back in Pangia. Chad and Dylan had started printing the Bible. This last week Chad was able to get a small commentary of Joshua, Judges, and Ruth printed, on press #2 and keep me supplied with plates for the Bible and getting parts while I have been concentrating on printing the Bible on press #1. We have 12 of the 30 signatures done of the Bible. We have less than 6 weeks before the Pastors conference so please pray we can get it done plus other materials to help the Pastors. Please remember my Pastor Jonathan Doss and his wife Sara as they travel here. He has an inner ear problem and if he gets jerked to much he could be pretty sick for several days and PNG roads are not good. Pray for the meeting. Sept 22-26. Plus others we will have while he is here.

I mentioned Canoli last prayer letter. When we came back to Pangia, Pastor Canaan (one of the Bible institute students) told me Canoli had made a profession of faith. Later the same day Canoli told me about it. Amen. This Sunday I will be going to preach at their church.

We set up the tent for the first time in Mendi at Mendi Baptist Church. It was beautiful. I have given them the tent/to use in the upper and central Southern Highlands. Pastor Rex Lahari will make good use of it. With the approval of my home church and Wood Mizer, I sold the wood mizer to a village line. Money going into our needs to keep the printing press going. I had plans for the mizer and tent but with my neck condition God had other plans. I really like his plans. I am just a vessel.

In closing Gwendy is over her pneumonia. It was a long battle. Also Wesley has battled the mumps and we believe no one else will get the measles. I feel strong physically for the first time in a long time. We all covet your prayers. Thanks for everything you all do for us.
