



Kia who started coming to church in July after our first market outreach here in Taurama was under heavy conviction unbeknownst to me. The next day he came to me and gave a testimony that he was saved that night. I rejoiced with him. Yet was waiting for him to testify to the church. On Dec. 24th he text and said he wanted to give a testimony to the church.

So on the 25th he stood up and testified more than he had said to me, how he had gone forward with a bunch of people and stood in line at a church and said the sinners' prayer in 1985. Then he joined a Pentecostal church in 1991 and was saved. But he said in both instances there was just a head knowledge and no change and he went back to old life. Continue to pray for our outreaches. The brethren passed out 25,000 tracts at the FIFA Under 20 World Cup. People from many nations were given tracts. The theme of the WC was ending violence and promoting peace. N. Korea won. How fitting.

This week we were down to our last tracts and are waiting for more to arrive. But God is so good. We picked up a couple from the airport and took them to lunch yesterday as they had a 3 hour layover in Port Moresby on their way to the highlands to visit with the Fairs. She had brought a bunch of tracts with her to give them to us. Amen. Also there are two boxes at post office. One I believe is tracts the other is for Wesley who just turned 8.

Please continue to pray as we labor giving the word of God to the folks. It's what we came to do. It is a blessing that Kia went home and reread the scriptures from service that night and really wanted the Lord, and was saved.
