Dear Praying Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Nov. 19, 2016

For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries. I Cor 16:9

We want to start by thanking all those who support us in prayer and finances. Special thanks to those who have printed tracts, ordered tracts and sent them, made and sent banners for outreach, also shirts with scriptures, plus sent English Bibles and spiritual books to strengthen the saints here. Was also able to get some small concordances to give to the men faithful in coming too. These are all tools we have been able to use and will use.

Over the last 2 months we have continued to do the market services in several areas. Please pray for these outreaches as we have liberty to preach to many people complete messages. They listen and take tracts afterwards and we know decisions are being made either for God or against. But one thing they know is Christ died for sinners and they must repent and believe.

The FIFA under 20 women's World Cup is now going on here in PNG. Vali, Anna and I were at the match between Spain and Japan passing out tracts and holding scripture banners yesterday. Due to there being FIFA delegates here we had opposition. That's a first here. Anna was told she couldn't pass out the racially divisive material. She was kind but told the man that they were not racial but spoke of Christ. Then he told a national to confiscate the banners. The national did not comply. Anna brought them out to me and I just used them between the ticket counter and entrance. We will be at it again on the 21st and then the 25th. We were able to give tracts to several people from other parts of the world. Was able to witness and give tracts to the police, defense force and correctional officers patrolling the outside of stadium. Also gave a handful of tracts to a representative of the Ghana soccer team. Pray they passed them on to the girls. One day picking up our washing machine from repair shop was able to give tracts to a Malaysian, Filipino, and a man from Bangladesh plus an Australian and several nationals. Hmmm. Salvation is not racist. Christ died for all. Amen and Amen!!

Gwendy's cyst in her left kidney has not grown and the doctor believes it will stay that way. Anna's hip is fine outside of some need to strengthen it. (Was hit by Ambulance in 2011 so was just getting it checked) My 1½ year CT Scan was clear and x-rays looked good. While in Cairns was able to preach at Coastline Baptist and also Grace Baptist on the tablelands. Had some great fellowship with the saints there. Brother Wayne Fair stayed at our home and preached the services for us in Port Moresby (POM). He has been in POM getting his plane off the ship, reassembled and going through the process of complying with all the PNG regulatory items and is close to being able to fly it up to the highlands.

Upon returning to POM (from Medical checks) we were in front of 15 white shirted young boys with ties, and with black elder name tags on, coming through immigration. Yes Mormons. I have witnessed too many already since being here. And now there are a lot more here. Much can be written about the contending for the faith we have had over the last two months. One called me today to talk. So Kia and I went and there were 10 of them. They were given scripture so pray for them. Have also had some pretty interesting dealings with men who call themselves apostles but are not. Have interrupted their healing services and preached the word of God. Had a group called the Potters House, raffling a car, refrigerator and a computer so they can build a church, doing this 25 yards from where I was preaching. It is almost as if I am at Mars Hill and witnessing the same thing Paul did. It's a spiritual deceptive free for all.

Two weeks ago we had our first baptism service. Brother Cosmas (17) had come to me a few weeks earlier and said he had called upon the name of the Lord Aug 10th, after coming to ask me about salvation that evening. I gave him the scriptures concerning Christ and left it with him. He went home and made that very important call. Amen. He is first to church and faithful to outreach when he isn't in school. And also faithful to men's Bible study. He gave a wonderful testimony of salvation in front of the church and that evening we walked to the beach and peached and baptism. Now I walk with him to school some mornings and have held Bible devotions outside the school before it starts. The school is on a military base, so we walk through military housing and I have more than on one occasion taken over 2 hours to make the 20 minute walk home. So many people to stop and witness too. May times at 8:30 in the morning the military men and family members are drunk. One occasion I walked up to a group of young people outside their home who were listening to loud music and drinking and asked them to turn off radio and just put my arms around the shoulders of two of the young men and just prayed for God to help them through the day, have mercy on them and when they sober up let them read the tracts. I ask you to please pray as it is a cesspool of sin. But God commendeth his love towards us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us. Rom 5:8 Gods love is so amazing. Nothing is hidden yet he loved us enough to die for us. Glory to His Name!
