Dear Praying Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Aug 8, 2017

I again start this prayer letter with a special request. This time my mother, Barbara is in the hospital. Her colon ruptured 23rd of July and she is still recovering in the hospital. Surgery went well but being 83 years old makes recovery a little complicated. She'll turn 84 Aug 10th. My Dad is recovering well from his strokes.

As I was walking from the bus stop to my first day as Chaplain at the hospital July 1st, a man disembarked from another bus and runs up to me and says, "Pastor I want to receive Jesus Christ". He said he had heard me preach several times in the market. I began telling him about the heart needing to receive the Word of God. As we walked across the asphalt, I explain it was too hard, and the seed couldn't take root, then walking on the hard, dry, parched ground, I told him perchance the seed here gets a little water it may spring up but it would not produce anything. Went on to say how a humble broken heart can receive God's word. At this point we had arrived at the front gate of the hospital. I stopped to witness more, he stopped me in midsentence and asked if I could give him some bus money. Glad I was patient and not all about getting a profession.

Two Sundays ago as I was preaching on 'Have You Found Grace in the Eyes of God'. Teresa called upon the Lord to save her unbeknownst to me. After service I was talking to her husband Kia (he was saved end of last year), when she came up to me and said "Pastor, Can I talk to you?" We sat down and then she told me how during the preaching God spoke to her heart about him wanting to save her. She said it was like a light came on. She understood and she prayed to God confessing she was a sinner, and believing in her heart Christ Jesus died for her and washed her sins away in his blood. Amen!! The following Sunday she gave her testimony and we had a baptismal service this past Sunday. God soften a hard heart. Amen again!!

The church voted to accept a piece of land that was given to us on May 21st. The offer was made several months ago and we had been praying for the Lords will to be done. It was the second piece of land offered. The other had a beautiful view of the ocean yet about 1/2 mile away. This was only 150 yards from our rental (no ocean view). I had received a small pension unexpectedly and a small inheritance. Plus money we had been saving the last year. Lease was up July 1st so we made a decision on the land and to invest what we had here in PNG and started building May 22nd. The man that was building the home with his crew walked off the job June 22nd. Felt like a punch to the stomach. Yet had peace quickly. His name was Tiki and I had witnessed to him a lot and prayed with him and he left. But worse yet he had knocked out his (3rd) wife earlier that morning. She was found in the outhouse hours later. Seems he needed to get out of town. Took his crew and tools too. Minor set-back. Not really they let us in a bad situation. But we survived. So we were homeless from July 1-15 and moved in on the 15th. Good news: I have been gaining more use than I ever thought I would have with my prosthesis enhanced left shoulder and my right shoulder has improved also. Thankful for that.

I could write a whole other prayer letter on the Chaplaincy work at the hospital. July was a tough month. The first two week of July did over 56 hours at hospital while trying to get house to where we could move in and all the church services. Survived. Aug. I am scheduled Mon, Thurs, Sat- 8-4. Many to pray for. Seen everything from Leprosy to man who died of knife wound to head. If anyone would be interested in praying for people I come across please let me know. I'll send out weekly letter to those interested. I have stayed to 6pm several times and don't even get back to many people for several visits. It needs someone full time. A few special request. Anne- fourth stage breast cancer. Wonderful witness with her Monday. Katsi- fell off telephone pole- knows he needs Christ. Then there is Racheal- Same cancer I had. Her arm broke when she tugged on her brother's shirt back in Jan. Now it looks like a baseball on the outside of her arm and has spread to her lungs and left shoulder. She has a good attitude and says she is saved. Not much time left. Many, many more. 1 in 5 people at the hospital have TB. Some now drug resistant. Pray for me to as I come into contact with people from all over PNG with all kinds of sicknesses and beliefs that keep them from getting proper help. Very draining work. Sunday night 25 were shot in a political fight. Doors open with Doctors and Nurses also.

We received our 3 year visa's, so good to 2020. Will apply for permanent Visa's soon. Anna is in Australia and she will come back in Sept. Lord is adding to Fellowship of Bible Believers Baptist Church as we continue to plow.

In closing I received a call Saturday night. Ivan was chopped to pieces. Ivan was the one who gave us so much trouble in Yaria. Sad as he is now in hell after rejecting the gospel. Sad indeed. This happened in another political fight. There is a lot of unrest in the country now. More than I have ever seen. Elections just finished and they formed the new parliament.
