Dear Praying Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thanks so much for the prayers. A few prayer letters back I asked for prayer for several people. Four of them, Kai, Rachael, Vali and his wife Ruth followed the Lord in believer's baptism Sunday the 12<sup>th</sup>. Each of them stood before the church and gave their testimony of how they came to the Lord Jesus Christ. It was the most encouraging service I have been a part of in my 8 plus years here. Rachael has come to the Lord through the change that has happened in Vali and Ruth's life. Ruth because she saw a change in her husband's life. Yes II Cor 5:17 is a true verse. Therefore if any man be in Christ he is a new creature.... They all came to the Lord because the Holy Spirit of God dealt with them about their sinful condition, they repented towards God and believed on the Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:21 They faithfully came to church and heard the preaching and God got a hold of them and showed them their sinful, ungodly condition. Couldn't sleep, some for several days and each finally just got on their knees and called upon the Lord believing and received him. They had all tried to be religious and testified through the preaching of the cross they saw their need and Christ as their hope. I did my part in sowing and watering, God did his part in opening their understanding and they did their part in calling. God brought the increase. Pray as I believe several others are under conviction.

In Dec. I applied for a pass to go into the main hospital to minister to the sick. February we received it. Only for Thursdays 12-1pm. So our first trip in about 4 weeks ago I met Otto. He had messed up his neck and had been in traction about 7 weeks. I had an excellent witness with him. He had had a lot of time to think and was definitely attentive. A few weeks ago, I had John speak with him as I went to witness to others I have been seeing each week. Well after we left I asked John how it went with Otto. He told me they had good conversation on the scriptures and I said I know he is listening and thought you could maybe water some more and he would get saved. John looked at me and said. He said he got saved the first day you talked to him. John thought I knew that. I am just not one looking for decisions but sow and water and then let the Lord do the work of getting that seed to spring up and bear fruit. I look at it this way. When a farmer works the ground, plants the seed and fertilizes and waters and God sends rain and the sun, he isn't out there trying to talk the seed into coming up. Doesn't beg, plead etc.... He has done his part. Now it's God that has to give that dead seed life. Well Otto was checked out that same day so I couldn't follow up. God knows and I'll see him in heaven if he did. That's what is great when God saves someone. He will care for his children. Hebrews 13:5b

Many at the hospital come from other parts of the country because there is not proper care where they are from. Right now the Hospital has no insulin. Freddy who is a diabetic and lost his leg is not getting medicine along with a lot of others. Christina is a 5 year old who needs an operation on her brain but is starving to death and they are not giving her intravenous fluids. They want her grandpa to take her home till she gets strengthened. She will go home and die. We get there before 12 and leave way after 1pm and don't even get out of the one ward of 12. A woman Gwendy spoke too had two broken arms given to her by her husband who actually was a nurse on that Ward. They actually moved him to another ward. Yet he isn't in jail. Though everywhere it is talked about ending domestic violence. Empty talk. Michael an 18 year old was chopped in the head at Manu market and can hear but not talk. We see improvement each time we go. Two other men were having bleeding on the brain from being hit over the head with a bottle and the other a tree limb. Manu is the bus stop and market we preach and tract often. Once more the hospital is another open door to witness to the lost and strengthen the afflicted who are saved.

The CEO of Hospital Dr. Gupta has asked to meet with me. I am waiting to hear back from him. Please pray for this meeting. Hopefully it's about his need for a Savior as I had one opportunity to meet him and had a short witness. His wife is a Doctor also and Gwendy had an appointment with her and was able to talk to her and give her a tract. Think it is more about them wanting a Chaplain at the hospital.

We have just ordered over 100,000 more tracts. And some more KJV Bibles. Favorite tract is "Can't get blood out of a Kau Kau". Picture of a Kau Kau on front. (That's Sweet potato)

Anna is doing well in Kerema teaching the 1<sup>st</sup> graders. Will be good to see her again in April.

We had some visitors from Old Paths Baptist Church Greece NY. Pastor Folk and 4 others. They were going to visit a missionary out of their church but we were able to do an outreach together and they were with us Last Sunday and also Tuesday for our Men's and women's Bible studies. We had 13 boys and 14 girls and David and Megan took them and had Bible studies with them while Brother Folk gave a study to the men and Sis Folk did for the ladies and also Sis Sue Fair did also for Ladies.

Bro Fair hopefully is flying his airplane for the first time today with Matt Allen. Then hopefully by the end of the month he can get it to Mt. Hagen. Pray God's will be done.

There are some serious fights on many fronts. Please pray!
